GENERAL INFORMATION

General Play:

During Ladies Day, no gimmies are permitted, except when playing Match Play.

All golf rounds are played following the Golf Canada Rules of Golf, unless otherwise directed. If you are unsure of a rule, please contact Jan Pelton for clarification.

Pace of Play – please keep up with the group ahead of you.

The Fixture List is available on the Ardmore Golf Course Website, under Membership, Ladies Club tab.

Tee Sheets:

Anytime you know you will be away, please let Terry know.

The Draw will be done on Sunday and the Tee Sheet will be sent out on Sunday evening. Please ensure you let Terry know on Saturday if you cannot golf Ladies Day.

If there are any last-minute cancellations, please call the clubhouse on Tuesday morning. Or email Terry and Kathy before 7:45.

Scorecards:

All scorecards should include Gross, Handicap, Net and Putts, unless otherwise directed.

Maximum three players per Scorecard. Four players will use 2 Scorecards.

Please put your completed, tidy, readable, dated, signed, and attested Scorecard in the grey box under the computer before you leave on Tuesday.

9 Hole Players should complete the side of the Scorecard in play that day. (Front Nine or Back Nine)

Please indicate any Chip-in or Birdie on the Scorecard.

Weekly Winners & Points:

One Point will be awarded to the weekly winner for Gross, Net and Lowest Puts in each Division.

Two Points will be awarded for every Chip-in and Birdie. Please ensure this is recorded on your Scorecard.

GENERAL INFORMATION

At the end of the season, the points will be converted into a dollar value. The money won will be handed out on the final Ladies Day of the season.

Closest to the Pin (KP):

There will be a KP almost every week and it will alternate between Hole #5 and Hole #14, depending on what the 9 Hole Players are playing that week.

No need to sign up or pay to participate.

Record your distance on the KP maker if you are the closest to the pin so far in the round.

The winner will receive \$15 the following Tuesday.

If no one makes the green, the prize money will NOT carry over.

Handicaps:

Handicaps are required and marked on your Scorecard. If you do not have a Handicap, please use 33 (thirty-three) until you get one.

Once we start playing off the Tee Boxes, all rounds played should be posted into the Golf Canada Handicap System unless the round does not meet the required number of holes played.

Use the Match Play Format when playing Match Play or Interclub Matches.

When playing 9 Holes, please halve your handicap.

Interclubs:

There will be 4 Interclub Matches played in 2024.

Interclub Teams will consist of 8 Players from Ardmore.

A sign-up sheet will be posted. Ideally, players should be available for both home and away games. If more than 8 players sign up, the team will be determined by the players with the lowest Net Scores from the most recent Tuesday's game.

9 and 18 Hole Players and all Handicaps are welcome.
