

ADDITIONAL RULES

1. **Plugged Ball** - there is no penalty for dislodging a plugged ball made by one of your hits. Relief is taken as close to the initial embedded spot as possible, no closer to the hole, keeping in mind that the player would also get relief from any casual water in the area.
2. **Unintentional Hit** - there is no penalty involved in that action, but the player must retrieve the ball and return it to its original spot, otherwise the ball is being hit from an incorrect location and the player would receive a two stroke, general penalty.
3. **Hole #17 Drop Zone Rules** - the drop zone (white disc) can only be used if the ball goes into the second pond from the teeing area, not the first. If the ball goes into the first pond from the teeing area, you may retee for 3 or drop the ball below the teeing area, (also for 3), The drop should be even with where the original ball crossed the red line of the first pond, going as far back on the line as you are able, if you so wish.
