Once on the grass tees, we can enter our scores on Golf Canada's website for handicap purposes for 'regular golf' events where your individual score is kept. <https://scg.golfcanada.ca/login> ***It is very important that you enter ALL your scores for ALL games you play, including 9 hole games - and not just Men's Club days.*** Golf Canada allows you to enter 7 holes for 9 and 14 for 18 if you can't complete a full round. Note: You must have a valid Golf Canada handicap to compete in Men's Club tournaments and events for prize money.
