

## **Ardmore Men's Club - Info Notice #5 - April 19, 2026**

### **Spring Cup Tournament April 22 & 29**

Also known as the Captain's Cup, this is the first of the Men's Club five "Major" tournaments of the season. It is an individual stroke play tournament with current handicaps at time of play over two 18-hole rounds as scheduled. Ties to be broken by an 18-hole playoff within seven days of the completion of the second round. Should competitors still be tied after this round a winner will be decided by playing a hole-by-hole sudden death playoff. There are usually four separate flights of handicap groupings, subject to total number of registered players.

### **Start Entering All Your Scores for Handicap Purposes**

With grass tees, please start entering your scores on Golf Canada's website for handicap purposes for 'regular golf' events. <https://scg.golfcanada.ca/login> ***It is very important that you enter ALL your scores for ALL games you play, including 9 hole games (and not just Men's Club days).*** And if you can't finish a full round, Golf Canada allows you to enter 7 holes for 9 or 14 for 18.

### **50/50 Charity Raffles**

**The first raffle event will be April 22 and 29**, with 50% of proceeds donated to the **Beacon Community Services Shoal Centre for Seniors** in Sidney. Tickets are \$2 for one or \$5 for three and will be sold at each morning meeting, with the draw to be held after golf on April 29.

### **FedUp Cup Points Race**

A fun season-long points race, inspired by the PGA's FedEx Cup, with points awarded most weeks to the best net scores for regular golf rounds. The FedUp Cup recognizes Men's Club players who score well consistently during eligible events through the season, with regular attendance also favouring the top points earners. Note: Points are not awarded for non-regular golf formats such as scrambles and novelty events.

At the end of the designated final FedUp Cup event, prizes are awarded to the top points earner overall, as well as the runner up. Some select season events offer "bonus" incentive points. Players are ranked each week for eligible events according to the scoring statistics, and points awarded, for example: 100 points for the best net score overall, with declining points to each successive score.
