Some of you may be wondering “What is Interclub competition”

An interclub competition in golf is a structured team tournament where members of one golf club play against teams from other local clubs. Typically featuring a Four-Ball (best-ball) match play on handicap format, teams compete for points based on holes won, often playing both home and away matches. It is a popular, friendly, and competitive way to experience different courses and foster camaraderie with golfers from other clubs.

Team Ardmore is comprised of eight Ardmore Ladies of any handicap level who are then paired in order of their handicap index (lowest to highest) to compete against two members from an opposing club with similar handicaps and skill levels.

The best net score of the partners on each hole wins that hole for the team. Points are awarded; 1 point for a win, ½ a point for a tie and 0 for a loss. Club points are totaled over the two matches to determine the overall winning club. There is no trophy for the winners it’s just for the fun of friendly competition.

Please watch for the Signup Sheet! The first will be posted near to the first match and the subsequent sheets will be posted closer to the dates of play...

Also, note when entries are oversubscribed participants will be determined by using the best net scores from each player’s most recent Tuesday Game.

Reciprocal green fees are offered by some of the clubs. If not, green fees are the responsibility of the players. Carts are an extra charge.
